Miguel Bonachea, a native of Santa Clara, Cuba, is a classical guitarist and educator trained at the National School of Music and the University of Arts in Havana. He studied with distinguished teachers including Rolando Moreno, Efraín Amador, Flores Chaviano, and Jesús Ortega, and participated in master classes with internationally renowned guitarists such as Leo Brouwer and David Russell.

A prizewinner in several national and international competitions, Bonachea has appeared at major guitar and contemporary music festivals throughout the Americas and Europe. As a guest soloist, he has performed with orchestras in Cuba, Colombia, Bulgaria, Slovakia, and the United States.

In addition to his performing career, Bonachea has held teaching and leadership positions at leading music institutions in Cuba and Colombia. He currently resides in Vero Beach, Florida.

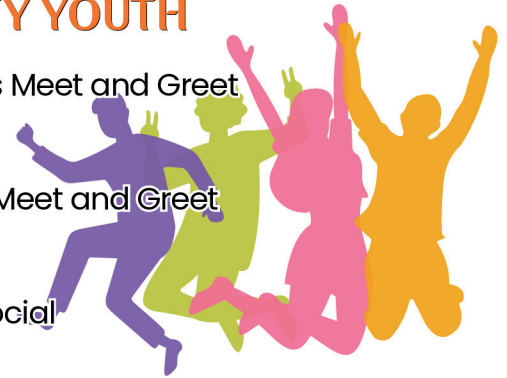
