THE MUSIC & FINE ARTS MINISTRY WELCOMES ASSOCIATE DIRECTOR

Please join us in a warm welcome to our new Associate Director of Music and Organist! **Su Lee**, originally from Busan, South Korea is a contemporary music composer and organist who works between Korea and the United States. Influenced by postwar European political composers during her studies in Germany, her later work consistently reflects an ongoing inquiry into the relationship between music and society.

Her compositions are characterized by experimental approaches utilizing microtonality, extended techniques, layered timbre, and overtone structures, transforming cultural and social questions into musical language. For her, artistic activity is both an aesthetic inquiry and a practice that connects music and society, inseparable from her faith. She understands music ministry as a liturgical act embodying love, justice, and compassion, and looks toward serving creative worship at the Community Church of Vero Beach, where faith and artistic expression meet, trusting in the path she believes God has prepared.

Su Lee holds a B.M. in Composition from Pusan National University, an M.M. in Integrative Composition from Folkwang Universität der Künste, and both an M.M. in Organ Performance and a Ph.D. in Composition from the University at Buffalo, SUNY. She is the founder and composer of the contemporary music composer-performer collective Studio frische Klänge, based in Busan, and is preparing for life in Vero Beach with two adopted rescue dogs—imagining the day they will run freely along the shoreline.
