2026 Stewardship Update

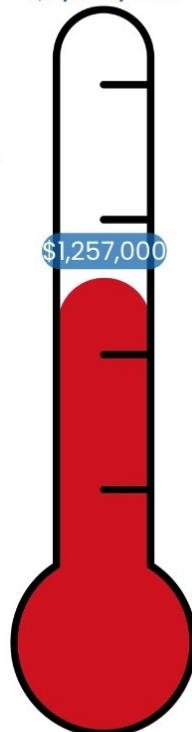
To date, we have received combined commitments of **\$1,257,000**, representing **63%** of the church's stewardship goal. Participation is **48** households behind last year's total.
