MISSION SPOTLIGHT

Next Week in Worship we'll hear from Jewel Davis from the Mission Ministry to highlight two organizations we have been supporting for many years.



Shining Light Gardens – Since 2008, Joel Bray and his team of volunteers have been driven by *"the vision to join together in unity with the body of Christ to make an impact in our community, and to have compassion for others as Jesus did"*. What an impact they have made!

On 20 acres of cultivated land, volunteers prepare the soil, plant and harvest crops, and distribute fresh produce to more than 21 Indian River County agencies that serve food-insecure individuals and families. In addition, they grow and arrange flowers that are delivered or made available to VNA Hospice, local churches, and other community organizations, bringing comfort and encouragement to those facing difficult circumstances.



Our Father's Table – Guided by Christian principles of compassion and service, Our Father's Table Soup Kitchen has served the Indian River County community since 1988. In 2025, the organization provided 39,250 meals to individuals in need, with demand expected to grow as economic challenges continue to impact low-income residents.

Volunteers prepare and serve hot meals to approximately 50 food-insecure individuals at Mt. Zion AME Church in Gifford. In addition, meals are delivered six days a week to 75 homebound residents using a van donated by The Community Church of Vero Beach in 2016.
